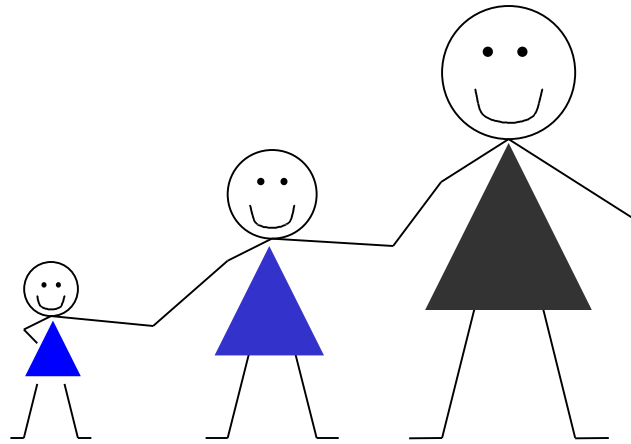










	noun	A noun is a word that names a person, place, thing, quality, or act.
	article	An article is any of the following three words used to signal the presence of a noun: a, an, the.
	adjective	An adjective is a word that modifies (describes) a noun.
	verb	A verb is a word that expresses action, existence, or occurrence.
	preposition	A preposition is a word that shows the relationship of a noun to a verb, an adjective, or another noun.
	adverb	An adverb is a word that modifies (describes) a verb, an adjective, or another noun.
	pronoun	A pronoun is a word that substitutes for a noun.
	conjunction	A conjunction is a word that connects other words, phrases, or sentences.
	interjection	An interjection is a word, phrase, or sound used as an exclamation and is capable of standing by itself.
